CSW69/Beijing+30

March 10-21, 2025

In 2025, the global community will mark the thirtieth anniversary of the Fourth World Conference on Women and adoption of the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action (1995). The sixty-ninth session of the Commission on the Status of Women (CSW69) will take place at United Nations Headquarters in New York from March 10 to 21, 2025.

This year's CSW priority theme focuses on the review and appraisal of the implementation of the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action and the outcomes of the 23rd special session of the General Assembly. The review will include an assessment of the current challenges affecting the implementation of the Platform for Action and the achievement of gender equality and women's empowerment, as well as its contribution to the full realization of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

In 1995, the Beijing Platform for Action extensively referenced the relationship between care and gender equality. The Beijing+30 review thus presents a critical moment to convene and discuss ongoing progress, achievements, challenges, and opportunities for advancing the care agenda.
